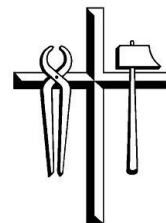

Resp. Psalm: Proclaim the wonders of the Lord among all the peoples.



In today's Gospel reading we see the first public sign and miracle which Jesus performed. First by his presence, and second by saving them from embarrassment when the wine ran out. Changing water into wine was a remarkable act of kindness; in the Old Testament wine is seen as both a gift and blessing of God. This miracle signifies the "new rich wine" of the Gospel and it points to the "wine of the new covenant" and the "bread of life" which Jesus provides for his disciples in the Lord's Supper or Eucharist. The miracles of Jesus demonstrate the power of God's love and mercy for his people. It is the ultimate expression of his love which is revealed in the person of his Son,

our Lord Jesus Christ. He became flesh for our sake, and he died for our redemption, and he rose that we, too, might be raised up and glorified with him. Do you thirst for God and for the abundant life and blessings he offers to you?

"Heavenly Father, you have revealed your glory in our Lord Jesus Christ. Fill me with your Holy Spirit that I may bring you glory in all that I do and say."
