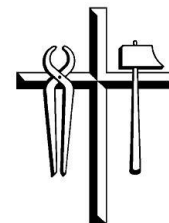

Do you know the peace which surpasses all understanding (Philippians 4:7)? In his farewell discourse Jesus grants *peace* as his gift to his disciples. What kind of peace does he offer?
