New Gift Aid Envelopes & Gift Aid Scheme: *The Gift Aid scheme* remains an important way of increasing your offertory collection. It is available to **all UK taxpayers**. You are not required to give a specific amount every week but, whatever you give through donations, Sunday offertory collections, Mass intentions, etc. will be increased by the Government by 25% at no extra cost to you. If you are not on the scheme and would like to be part of it all you need to do is to complete and sign the *Gift Aid declaration form*. To do so speak to Sally (Gift Aid Coordinator), one of the ushers at the door or contact the Parish Office, please.

- If you are already on the scheme and use *Gift Aid Envelopes* your *new Gift Aid Envelopes 2026/2027* should be ready for collection;
- If you cannot find your envelopes this means you may need to sign a new declaration form.
